Tax Collector's Office Launches Express Lane for Vehicle Registration Renewals

Next-Day Pick-Up Now Available at Plantation Office

Plantation, FL (July 21, 2025) – Broward County residents can now enjoy a faster, more convenient way to renew their vehicle, boat and mobile home registration with the introduction of the Express Lane at the Tax Collector's Office in Plantation. This new next-day service expedites the registration process, allowing residents who renew online at BrowardTax.org to collect their updated documents within 24 hours.

The launch of the Express Lane is a part of the Tax Collector's ongoing efforts to modernize operations ahead of assuming local driver license services in the summer of 2026. Additional enhancements in technology and facilities are currently underway to increase efficiencies.

"My office is focused on streamlining processes, making our services more convenient and accessible to residents. That's why we are excited about the launch of the Express Lane. It's another step in delivering innovative, customer-focused solutions," said Broward County Tax Collector Abbey Ajayi.

Registration renewals can be submitted up to three months prior to expiration, and customers may still opt to receive their documents by mail without visiting the office. Residents can learn more about registration renewal options at BrowardTax.org.

The Broward County Tax Collector's Office (BCTC) was established as an independent agency by the Florida Constitution in January 2025. Broward County's first Tax Collector, Abbey Ajayi, currently serves 2.1 million residents with property tax, tangible property tax, business tax, vehicle and vessel registration and titles, disabled parking permits and hunting and fishing licenses. In the summer of 2026, the Tax Collector's Office will also assume local driver license operations.
