Broward County Tax Collector's Office Partners with FLOW to Support Educators

Mobile Driver Licensing Event for Teachers in Broward a Success

Tamarac, FL (August 5, 2025) – The Broward County Tax Collector's Office recently partnered with Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to host a Florida Licensing On Wheels (FLOW) event for Broward Teacher's Union (BTU). Dozens of appointments were held for teachers needing to update their driver license, with some services completed in as little as 10 minutes.

While the Broward County Tax Collector's Office continues to strategize improvements for driver license services set to launch under its leadership in the summer of 2026, the office is creating opportunities to deliver for Broward residents now. This includes coordinating FLOW events in local communities and making these essential government services more readily accessible to all residents across the county.

"As teachers and staff head back to school, we wanted to alleviate concerns for those needing driver license services, especially at a time when obtaining an appointment is still difficult. Working alongside FLOW and BTU to make this event possible means our teachers can now return to their classrooms with updated driver licenses and one less worry," Broward County Tax Collector Abbey Ajayi said. "We want teachers and all residents to know: we are here to help."

The office encourages those who can renew online to skip the trip. If needed, residents can make an appointment at any FLHSMV service center at [FLHSMV.gov](https://flhsmv.gov) or with FLOW in their neighborhood by contacting their State Representative. If an appointment is necessary, customers should verify what documents to bring before arriving.

The Broward County Tax Collector's Office (BCTC) was established as an independent agency by the Florida Constitution in January 2025. Broward County's first Tax Collector, Abbey Ajayi, currently serves 2.1 million residents with property tax, tangible property tax, business tax, vehicle and vessel registration and titles, disabled parking permits, and hunting and fishing licenses. In the summer of 2026, the Tax Collector's Office will also assume local driver license operations.

The BCTC's mission is to provide excellent service that is rooted in integrity, efficiency and transparency, and to foster community trust through fair tax collection, strengthening public resources and supporting a prosperous future for all.
