## **Tax Collector Abbey Ajayi Announces Launch of Self-Service Kiosks Across Broward**

**Broward County, FL (January 22, 2026)** – The Broward County Tax Collector is announcing a countywide expansion of self-service vehicle registration and tag renewal kiosks after hosting ribbon-cutting ceremonies this week at partnering Sedano’s Supermarkets and Publix stores. The Tax Collector is also excited to introduce this kiosk for the first time ever in a Sedano’s Supermarkets location, representing an important step toward reaching all residents and ensuring equitable access to services within diverse communities.

“This expansion reflects our commitment to bringing services closer to residents and into the communities where they live, work, and shop,” said Abbey Ajayi, Broward County Tax Collector. “By expanding kiosk access across Broward County, we are making routine transactions more convenient while continuing to modernize how we serve the public.”

The self-service kiosks provide residents with a fast and convenient way to complete standard vehicle registration and license plate decal renewals without visiting a Tax Collector service center. Transactions are completed in under two minutes using a secure, user-friendly touchscreen, with registrations and tags printed instantly on site. Kiosks are ADA-compliant, accept secure electronic payments, and offer multilingual support.

Pembroke Pines Mayor Angelo Castillo and Coral Springs Vice Mayor Nancy Metayer Bowen celebrated the expansion in their respective cities and the continued commitment to improving access to essential services. Sedano’s Supermarkets and Publix leadership were also represented.

The newly installed kiosks support standard renewals and are currently available at the following 10 locations:



The Broward County Tax Collector's Office (BCTC) was established as an independent agency by the Florida Constitution in January 2025. Broward County's first Tax Collector, Abbey Ajayi, currently serves about 2 million residents with property tax, tangible personal property tax, business tax, vehicle and vessel registration and title work, disabled parking permits, and hunting and fishing licenses. Beginning in the summer of 2026, the Tax Collector's Office will also assume local driver license operations.

BCTC's mission is to provide excellent service rooted in integrity, efficiency and transparency, and to foster community trust through fair tax collection, strengthening public resources and supporting a prosperous future for all.




